In Addition, Ministry of Planning of Iraq, in collaboration with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), launched the “Iraqi SDG Investors Map” – an investment map to advance the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in Iraq. The launch included senior ministry officials, university presidents and key stakeholders. [Read](#)

Al-Mustaqbal University (UOMUS) was actively present at the launch, represented by its President Hasan Shaker Majdi. He emphasised that the university has adopted a “Towards a Sustainable University” initiative and is implementing a range of development-oriented projects aligned with the SDGs, such as protected-area management, mushroom-and protected-agriculture labs, a renewable energy research centre, a green-transport initiative and student-led projects with investment-potential.

Then he noted the university’s commitment to the “entrepreneurship” agenda launched by the Prime Minister and the university’s leading ranking among private universities in Iraq due to its production-model, industry partnerships and strong research capacity.



On April 27, an ad hoc event was held at Al-Mustaqbal University (UOMUS) to mark the Arab World Financial Inclusion Day, in cooperation with the Central Bank of Iraq and eighteen private Iraqi banks. The event featured workshops on “The Impact of Financial Inclusion on Poverty Reduction” and “The Impact of Financial Inclusion on Economic Activity through Supporting Small Projects.”
